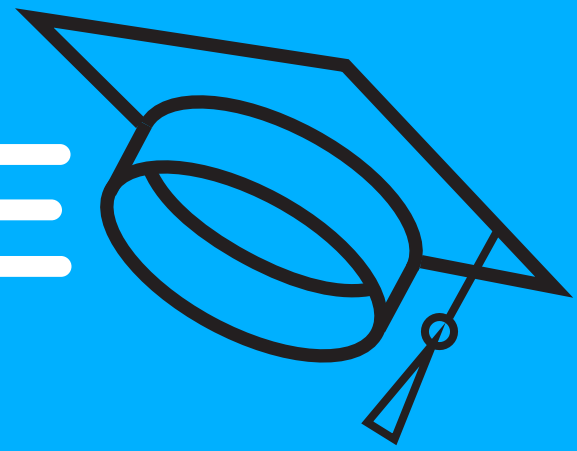

**First Graduate** is a nonprofit dedicated to supporting, empowering, and enabling first-generation college students to graduate from college. We are a 12-year+ free program—recruiting students in 6th grade. Offerings include homework and study support, test prep, school evaluation, field trips and school/university visits, scholarship and internship access, community building, career presentations from industry professionals, and more.

Behind these results is a growing ecosystem of mentors, educators, partners, and staff who show up for students in tangible ways. Whether through one-on-one mentorship, timely encouragement during moments of uncertainty, or steady advising through major transitions, students experienced a network that met them with care, consistency, and accountability.

We also continued to strengthen our approach to postsecondary success. In addition to college-readiness programming, we expanded opportunities in career exploration, financial literacy, and internships. These experiences help students translate aspiration into action and build skills that will serve them well beyond graduation.

At the organizational level, First Graduate remains on a firm footing. We exceeded our fiscal-year fundraising goal and continue to steward our resources responsibly, maintaining healthy operating reserves and a growing endowment. This stability allows us to plan thoughtfully, invest in staff, and expand programs where the need is greatest.

Looking ahead, our commitment is clear. We will continue to refine our programs, grow partnerships, and advocate for a future in which first-generation students are not navigating systems alone. # F<sup>1</sup>IRST GRADUATE ABOUT US

First Graduate empowers first-generation students in San Francisco with the guidance, resources, and support they need to succeed in college and beyond. Founded by philanthropist **Ann-Eve Hazen** and joined by **Anaflor (Smith) Graham**, our first program launched in 2001 and served 24 students from local middle schools.

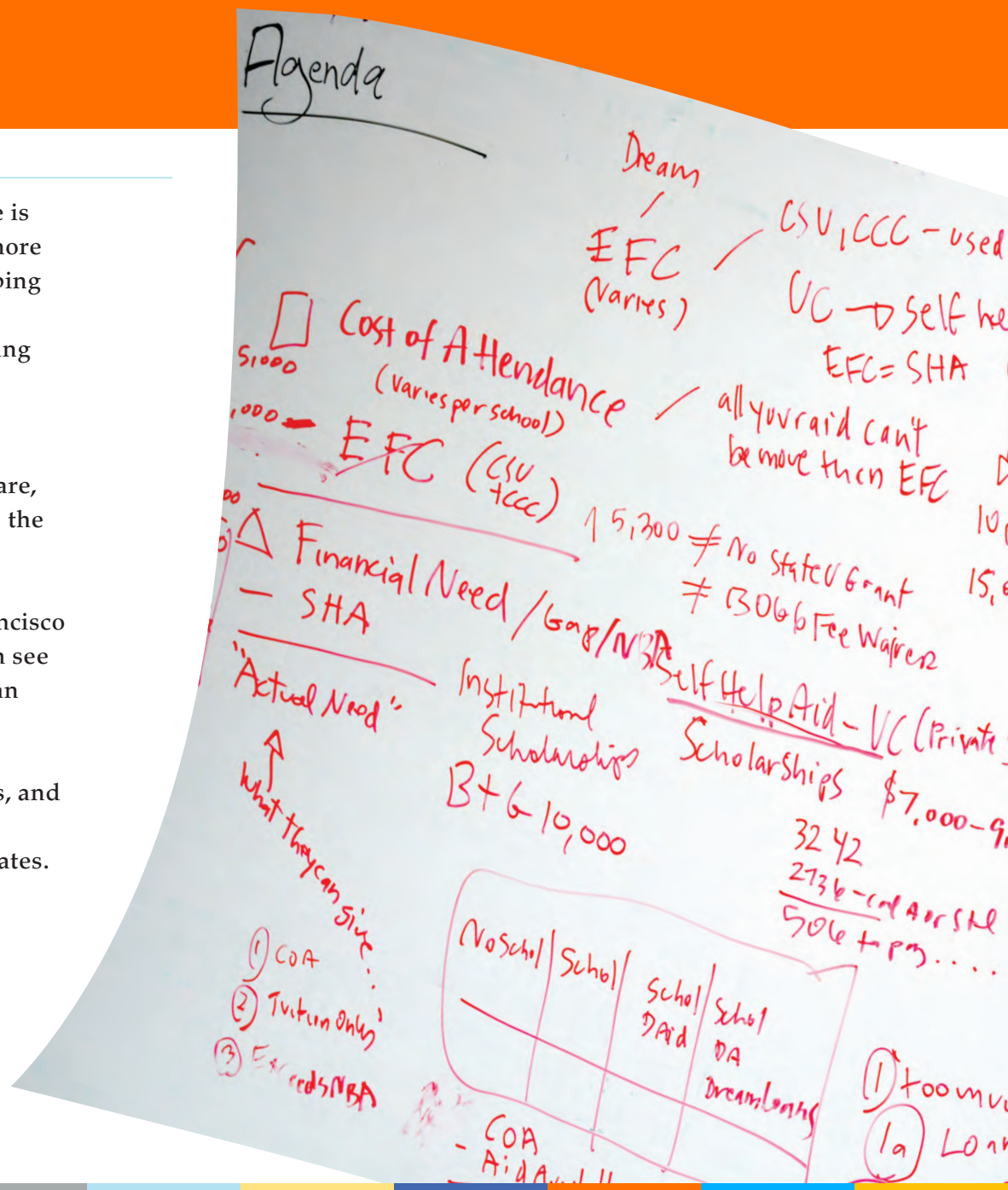
In 2024-25, we supported **more than 300 students in grades 6-12** and supported hundreds of alumni in pursuing and completing college degrees. **78% of our students earn a college degree within six years**, compared with 26% nationally for first-generation students.

Our programming begins in sixth grade with a summer launch through **Aim High**, an award-winning enrichment program. Students receive ongoing academic coaching and exposure to academic pathways, including company visits, career talks, and paid internships. **LaunchPad**, a partnership with **Deloitte**, prepares college seniors and recent alumni with career skills, from building resumes and LinkedIn profiles to navigating interviews and negotiating salaries.

**Collaboration is at the heart of our model.** This year, we strengthened our partnerships with nonprofits, corporations, and internship providers—including **PG&E, Deloitte, and Hamilton Zanze**—providing students with meaningful access to professional experiences and mentorship.

Looking ahead, First Graduate is expanding its reach to serve more students and families, developing citywide college-and career-readiness resources, and sharing best practices with other youth-serving organizations. Alumni achievements — from careers in technology, healthcare, and education — demonstrate the long-term impact of our work.

**Our vision is clear:** a San Francisco where every young person can see college as within reach, and can thrive with the support. Your partnership helps us remove obstacles, create opportunities, and inspire the next generation of first-generation college graduates.

## Academic Support.

Each student receives free academic instruction and homework help.



## Career Exploration.

Our students participate in career panels and events, resume writing and networking workshops, job shadow days, and mock interviews to gain exposure to career opportunities available to degree holders.



## Coaching & Guidance.

Our team tracks progress and works closely with students, families, tutors, mentors, teachers, and partner organizations to make sure that our students are successfully completing each step on the way to becoming college graduates.



## College Support.

We communicate with students consistently to ensure they are persisting through college and connecting with resources on campus. We also help our college students find paid summer internships.



## Family Engagement.

Students' families learn how they can support their children while they are on the path to becoming first-generation college graduates.



## Mentoring.

Students gain insight into college choices and professional careers from college-educated volunteers. Younger First Graduate students connect with older students and benefit from peer mentoring.



## School Counseling.

We coach students with the rigorous H.S. application process and their successful transition into 9th grade. We also provide intensive college counseling, standardized test preparation, college application planning, financial aid workshops, access to summer enrichment programs, college visits, and help with college scholarships.

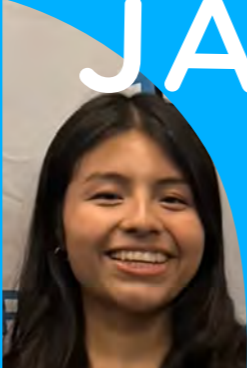
# STUDENT SPOTLIGHT
